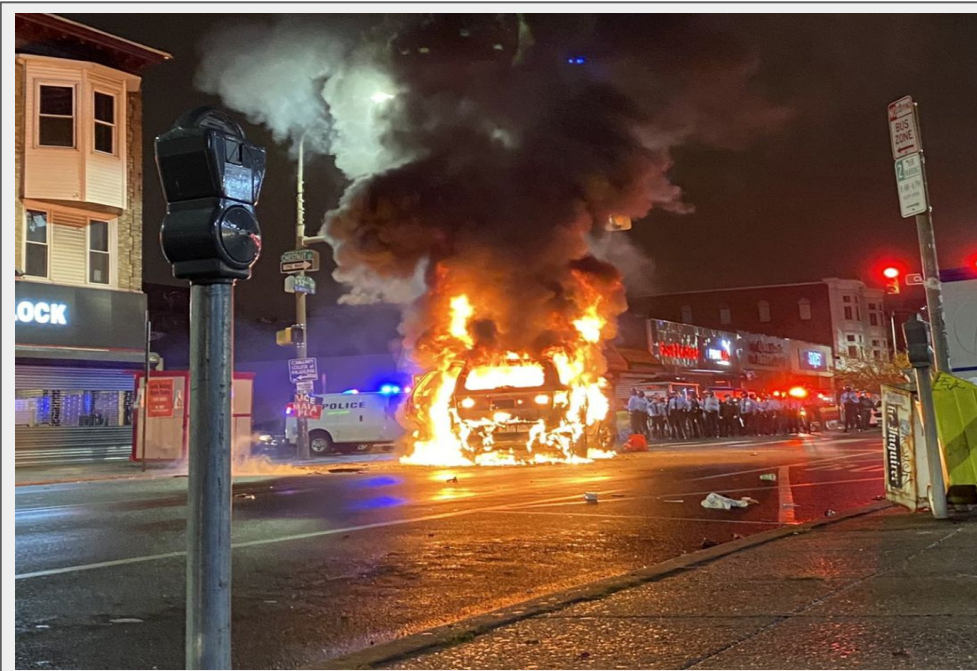


EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

SENATE: Democrats are sizing up leadership positions on the Senate Intelligence, Foreign Relations, Budget, Appropriations, and Banking committees should Republicans lose their majority. If President Trump wins reelection and Democrats take the Senate, we can expect a lot more investigations via the power of Intelligence and Foreign Relations committees.

STIMULUS: House Speaker Nancy Pelosi (D-CA) and Treasury Secretary Steven Mnuchin spoke today but failed to make progress on the next stimulus deal. The recovery so far has been fueled by stimulus and many question if there be a growth reversal once government programs expire. Another round of stimulus checks would likely have led to a short term economic boost, helping President Trump's reelection chances.

HECKLERS: Far Left groups plan to protest at the private homes of Republican Representatives and Senators following Election Day--including defeated candidates. While current activities don't yet rise to the level of the Maoist revolution, they are clearly part of the ongoing cultural revolution.



ANALYST COMMENT: Anti-fascist intelligence support provided information on police locations, undercover officers, and drone deployments in Philadelphia. Interestingly, the group initially discouraged live-streaming, but then called for live-streaming after they were unable to monitor frequently changing police frequencies. Lessons learned during these events will likely feed further refinement of intelligence support planned for post-Election Day disruptions. Solidarity disruption is already planned this week in Seattle, Portland, Chicago, and Denver.
